A total number of 614 were treated in the community and school dispensary. The number of children was 522 and the number of adults was 92.

- Antiacids eg. Ulgel and magnesium tablets
- Tabs cimetidine
- Tabs omeprazole

v. Antidiarrhea drugs such as:-

- Caps loperamide
- Diastop tabs
- Medistop suspension etc.

vi. Antiallergic drugs such as:-

- Injection Hydrocortisone, cream and Ointment
- Injection Piriton, cream and tabs

vii. Antibacterials such as:-

- Ampidox capsules and suspensions
- Amoxicillin capsules and suspension
- Injection procain penicillin fortified (PPF)
- Injection gentamyan
- Gentamyan ear and eye drops
- Ciprofioxacin tabs etc.

viii. Drugs for cold and flu such as:-

- Flugone capsules
- Coldcap capsules and syrup
- Piriton syrup and tablets

ix. Drugs for Ashmatic conditions eg:-

- Aminophylline Injection
- Sulbutamol tabs and syrup

x. Antipyretics, analgesics and anti-inflammatory drugs such as:-

- Diclofenac tabs and injection also gel
- Tabs. Brufen

- Caps. Piroxicam
- Caps. Indomethacim etc

Other services available includes:-

- Family planning and counseling
- Testing of HIV and AIDS

The available family planning methods include:-

- The use of Pills
- Injections
- Use of condoms

Both dispensaries have really served a great role of helping and treating patients freely. For example the school dispensary has taken the responsibility of deworming children frequently ie.

At least after 3 months and also by giving of vitamin A. in fact the availability of essential drugs has enabled many patients to be treated more especially those ones who can't afford to buy expensive drugs from the private chemist and clinics.
