

ST. MICHAELS CHILDREN AND COMMUNITY DISPENSARY REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2011 AND JANUARY – APRIL 2012

Both dispensaries serves children and people from around the area. In the year 2011 a total number of 850 patients visited the community dispensary and also a total number of 1400 children in the school dispensary, this included return cases.

MAJOR DISEASES TREATED

- I. Malaria
- II. Pneumonia
- III. Fungal infection
- IV. Burns
- V. Wounds
- VI. Helminthes(worms)
- VII. Diarrhoea
- VIII. Cough & Flu
- IX. Asthma
- X. Gonorrhoea
- XI. Cancelling and testing of HIV & AIDS

All the diseases mentioned above are treated in both dispensaries by quality and effective drugs.

DRUGS COMMONLY USED

- a. Antimalarials such as – A.L (Artemether and Lumefantrine)
 - Oroder
 - Fansider
 - Amodiaquin
 - Quinine for severe Malaria or Cerebral Malaria
- b. Antibacterial such as :- Injection X-pen, Injection P.P.F, Injection Gentamycin, Amoxycillin, Ampidox, Ciprofloxacin, Norfloxacin, Flagyl e.t.c.
- c. Antihelminthes such as:- Albendazole, Levamisole, Mebendazole e.t.c.
- d. Antifungal drugs such as:
 - Clozole cream
 - Sulpher ointment
 - Griseofulvin tablets
 - White field ointment
 - Bulkot cream e.t.c
- e. Antipyretics & Analgesics such as:- Paracetamol
 - Brufen
 - Diclofenac e.t.c
- f. Antiallergic drugs such as : - Hydroxotisone i.e injection, cream & ointment.
 - Piriton injection, tablets, syrup e.t.c.

Other drugs included cough expectorants and cough Suppressants and other many drugs for managerial of many conditions.

In the year 2012, which is from January-April this year, the community dispensary has received a total number of 362 patients and 600 children in the school dispensary.

The diseases treated are similar to those which have been listed.

Generally many people and children have benefited a lot especially those ones who can't afford to buy expensive drugs such as antibiotics and those ones who are unable to travel far looking for other health centers.

In the near future, the laboratory is going to more effective so that patients can first be tested before they are treated.

About your questions, here I have got the answers to your Association Project Synesius.

1. Regarding the School Dispensary

For the year 2011, the children that were treated in our facility were 1,400 with three consultations 850 patients were treated with at least three consultations.

2. During first four months of 2012, the community dispensary received a total number of 362 patients and 660 children in the school dispensary with at least three times consultations.
3. Regarding plans to unite both dispensaries. Due to lack of enough space in our facilities we are hoping to come up with mobile clinics that will serve both the community people and the children at large.
4. In 2011, we had a total number of 280 after we had lost one of our children who was suffering from AIDS and after sending others more to high school. This year we have a total of 275 children. For the next semester we are looking forward to at least construct some classrooms for our dear children.

ABOUT OTHER ISSUES

1. I am glad to realize that your project can also support our children who have dental problems at St. Bridget, we hope that our needy parents with same problems can also benefit. We also hope that for your continued support, we can also stabilize our small dental facility.
2. About the ambulance, we had already talked to Br. Emmanuel and plans are underway, to start outreach program in, Mathare and Kibera at large.
3. We are hoping to co-ordinate soon once the plans for ambulance starts.
